

Environmental Protection Department — Full Implementation of Plastic Shopping Bag Charging

McDonald's is in full support of the full implementation of Plastic Shopping Bag Charging by the Environmental Protection Department. Effective from April 1, 2015, our restaurants shall charge customers HK\$0.5 for each extra plastic bag subject to the conditions as listed below. As a further step to promote environmental protection, our restaurants will only offer plastic bag to customers upon request for any purchase of one drink in non-airtight packaging. These are step-up measures in an effort to encourage reduction in the use of plastic bags. We wish to join hands with our customers for a good cause -- Use less, waste less. Let's help build a green and sustainable Hong Kong together!

All customers are kindly reminded of the following items to which the Plastic Shopping Bag Charging will/ will not apply.

Plastic Shopping Bag Charge <u>WILL</u> be applied to the plastic bag containing these items/under the following condition:

- Packaged/ bottled drinks stored at room temperature
- Additional purchase of condiments in airtight packaging, e.g. McNugget sauce at extra charge
- Happy Meal toys/ books
- Non-food items, e.g. plush/ plastic toys, cups, gift certificates, freebies, party aifts
- Any extra plastic bag requested to hold products such as fries and burgers already contained in paper bags*

Plastic Shopping Bag Charge **WILL NOT** apply to:

- Food and drinks in non-airtight packaging
- Chilled food items and packaged/ bottled drinks
- Products in airtight packaging which come along with food and drinks at no extra charge, e.g. condiments, cutlery
- Umbrella plastic bags

All charges collected will be donated to the Plastic Shopping Bag Collaborative Platform formed by The Conservancy Association, Greeners Action and Green Power for promoting Bring Your Own Bag and supporting waste reduction projects.
